Christmas Party.

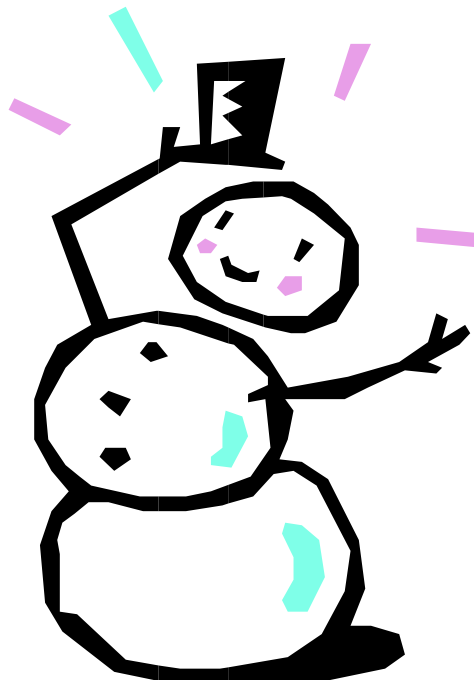
We will be having a Christmas party on Thursday morning. The children can bring in some party clothes to change into during the morning.
