

Phasing – the children’s viewpoint:

Current year six children will spend one term in mobile accommodation:

- In April, the children enter two mobile classrooms. From the start of the summer term, they will enter the site around the edge of the car park and beside the millennium garden. In June, they will need to enter via the infant school as the car park and offices will be handed over to Kier group.

Current year five children will spend two terms in mobile accommodation:

- In April, the children enter two mobile classrooms. From the start of the summer term, they will enter the site around the edge of the car park and beside the millennium garden. In June, they will need to enter via the infant school as the car park and offices will be handed over to Kier group.
- In September, they enter as new year sixes into a mobile classroom, as they did in April (the new car park will have been completed).
- In January 2012, they will enter the completed new classrooms.

Current year four children will spend one term in mobile accommodation:

- In April, the children remain in the year four teaching base, though losing the current phoenix classroom. From the start of the summer term, they will enter the site around the edge of the car park and beside the millennium garden. In June, they will need to enter via the infant school as the car park and offices will be handed over to Kier group.
- In September, they enter as new year fives into a mobile classroom, as they did in April (the new car park will have been completed).
- In January 2012, they will enter the completed new year five classrooms.

Current year three children will spend two terms in mobile accommodation:

- In April, the children remain in the year three teaching base, though losing the current griffin classroom. The cloakroom will become a teaching base and coats will move to the changing rooms. From the start of the summer term, they will enter the site around the edge of the car park and beside the millennium garden. In June, they will need to enter via the infant school as the car park and offices will be handed over to Kier group.
- In September, the children remain in the same teaching base, with the same cloakroom. They enter as new year fours as they did in April (the new car park will have been completed).
- In January 2012, they enter the mobile classrooms whilst the central area is demolished and the new year four area is built.

New year three children:

- In September, the children use the current year four teaching base, though without the current phoenix classroom. They will enter the site through the main entrance, with parents invited to hand over children and meet children in the hall.
- In January 2012, they will enter the completed new year three classrooms.
