Clare House, Tamilnadu, India



How to sign up

All places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.

To request your child's place this form must be returned as soon as possible. Once the club invitation letter is sent to you, the payment and reply slip need to be returned by the date asked to secure your place. Places which have not been secured by the date asked may be offered to other children on the waiting list.

If you do not receive an invitation letter it means that on this occasion your child has not been offered a place. Due to the sheer volume of numbers we do not send written notification if places are already full but please check with Ms Fox if there is any uncertainty.

Most clubs finish at 4:30pm and cost £2.50 per session. Clubs with different times or charges are listed with the cost per session. Please check out the school website or ask for our Breakfast and Tea Club registration form for a full breakdown of these particular charges. Please note that all Breakfast and Tea Club sessions now require booking and payment in advance.

Choir will continue with the children who are currently participating. Please let Ms Fox know if you no longer wish to have a place.

Anyone wishing to join our after school orchestra should, ideally, have already started to learn to play and have access to an instrument. As orchestra starts at 4pm, special tea club rates of £1.50 per session are available for anyone coming to tea club before orchestra starts.

Please note that with the exception of breakfast and tea clubs there will be no clubs in the first or final weeks of the half term.
