Other points to consider...

- Where possible, use pupil planner to communicate with staff
- Use the [admin@burevalley.norfolk.sch.uk](mailto:admin@burevalley.norfolk.sch.uk) email address to ask questions that can't be addressed through the pupil planner
- Let school know if you need support with internet access
- Talk with Mr Olney, Ms Fox, Mrs Pope or Mrs Howard if you have any pastoral concerns (we will be on the school playground every morning and afternoon)
- Expect a phone call or email from your child's teacher or teaching assistant by the end of September. This will also be an opportunity to discuss any concerns
- If your child or a member of your household shows Covid-19 symptoms, refer to the Parental Guidance document and follow the guidance
- When on school site, please maintain social distancing when you are near other parents
- There will be no breakfast or tea club during the first ½ term. This will be reviewed during October
- Please maintain good hand hygiene routines at home – we will re-enforce this at school.
- Face coverings are not required on the school site. Where a child chooses to wear one, there are robust procedures around the handling of these. (see Parental Guidance)
- Find out when PE day is – wear PE kit to school on these days. Check your child's planner after the first day back
