## MESSAGE FROM MR OLNEY, HEAD OF SCHOOL

Dear parents and carers,

This week, our wonderful Yr6 children sat their Key Stage Two SATs exams in school.

The way in which they have approached these tests has been praiseworthy. Hopefully their hard work will pay off and be reflected in their results.

Sitting any test can leave you feeling a little nervous, but the children have been focussed, resilient and really determined to give their best. The staff have been incredibly proud of each and every one of them. The children and their teachers have all worked tremendously hard throughout the year and we could not be prouder.

SATs tests are designed to check pupils understanding and recall of the key stage two maths, reading and spelling, punctuation and grammar knowledge. At the end of these exams children will be given a scaled score of between 80 to 120. Whilst that number will be used to judge the effectiveness of their schooling and will assist with their transition to high school, this number will not reflect the whole child and their individual personality, story, skills and interests.

We continue to tell our children to never be anything other than their wonderful selves. We are all on a journey and learning progress is never linear.

We look forward to welcoming parents, carers and family members into school next Wednesday and are excited about our themed week plans for the week beginning Monday 22 May.


